Plans for full reopening in September 2020



All children in Year 1 – 6 will return back to Brindishe Manor on Monday 7th September.



School attendance is compulsory, we would like all children back in school.



Each year group will form a 'bubble'. Although most learning will happen within the classroom, playtimes and lunchtimes will be mixed as a 'year group' bubble.



Children must sanitise or wash their hands every time they enter the school and at different times during the day. Teachers will reinforce how to keep hands clean. Please let the school know if you do not give permission for hand sanitiser to be used.




The school will be cleaned more regularly, during the school day and at the end of each day.



Please only arrive at your pick up time, we are trying to reduce the number of families in the playground.



You must leave as soon as you have collected your child.





Children will start in their new class, with their new teacher. Please see the larger map included in the Parent Booklet for more details.

Children will be given plenty of time to talk, share stories, worries.





Children must bring a labelled water bottle.

The classrooms will be set up so that the children are predominantly facing the front of the class.





There will be staggered break and lunchtimes where the children will be allowed to play outside in their zones.

Hot lunches will now be provided for those children who have a school dinner. Reception – Y3 children will eat their lunch in the lunch hall. Y4 – Y6 children will eat in their classrooms.





The lunch hall will be timetabled to allow only the year group bubbles in at one time. Each area will be cleaned before the next year group bubble enters.

Each child will be given all the equipment they needed. Children can bring pencil cases from home but they must stay at school for the half term.





Reading books will be sent home.

Children must come to school in their outdoor PE kit on their allocated PE day.
