#### **A great set of results for our 11 year olds Brindishe Green!**

The draft key stage 2 test results for children aged 11 years in our school for all three schools are on our website at [www.brindisheschools.org](http://www.brindisheschools.org) and we are delighted that they are some of the best results in Lewisham. We thought you would like to see how well Brindishe Green did in particular.

As you can see our children have achieved results that are **above both the Lewisham and national average** in Level 4s and level 5s in English and Maths. Our results rose again for the 5<sup>th</sup> year running. In both level 4 (the national standard expected for an 11 year old) and level 5 (the standard expected for more able children) our results are very high indeed and no doubt some of the highest in Lewisham.
