They were taken aback by the knowledge and conviction in the performance and commented that it, truly, was the very best interpretation they had been invited to since the celebration began 15 years ago.

Thank you children for what you achieved today and thank you, too to Mrs Sharrock, Ikram and Mark, from Small Nose Productions, for all the preparation and learning that fed in to today's performance.
