Updated Covid 19 Guidance

Please find below the most up to date information on what needs to happen if your child is showing signs of Covid19, or tests positive on a Lateral Flow Test.



- If your child is showing signs of Covid19 you must book a PCR test for them straight away. They must not come to school if they are showing signs of Covid.
- If the PCR is **negative** your child can come back into school. Please email proof of a negative PCR test to school as soon as possible.
- If your child is **positive**, you must follow the instructions given by NHS test and Trace. We also now ask you to email us proof of the positive test, please.
- Following new guidance, on self-isolation, please follow the grid at the bottom of the page. If your child has a negative LFT (Lateral Flow Test) on day 6 and day 7, they may return to school. Please email proof of the negative LF tests to the school office. This evidence should be the NHS notification you will receive following entering a negative result on the NHS website.
- If your child is **not showing signs of Covid19** but they **test positive on a LFT**, they must self-isolate at home. Under the new guidance, anyone in England who receives a positive lateral flow device (LFD) test result should report their result on gov.uk and must self-isolate immediately, but will not need to take a follow-up PCR test. If your child has a negative LFT on day 6 <u>and</u> day 7, they may return to school. Please email proof of the negative LF tests to the school office. This evidence should be the NHS notification you will receive following entering a negative result on the NHS website.
