Emergency procedures at Brindishe Green

As you will know, schools are obliged to have procedures for safe evacuation and invacuation – that includes getting everybody out of the building in the event of an emergency, or getting everybody inside safely.

The likelihood of a real emergency taking place is extremely low but, so that everyone can feel informed and confident, we practise our procedures at least once a term.

All the children are well prepared by their teachers so they know what to do when they hear the signals. This week we held our first 'invacuation' for the term and it went very well. We also had a successful 'evacuation' or 'fire drill' earlier this year.
