We had a fantastic turnout of prospective parents and carers visiting our school on Thursday. They were shown around by lots of our Y6 children – Brindishe Green Ambassadors – who did an amazing job of telling our visitors all about their school. Feedback from our visitors is that they were very impressed by the children who spoke articulately and with such enthusiasm about their learning and about our Brindishe Green values of respect, courtesy and valuing individual differences.

We are collecting donations for the Helping Hands Foodbank!

The 'Helping Hands Foodbank' is a joint project between the Church of the Good Shepherd with St Peter (in Lee) and Action for

Refugees in Lewisham (AFRIL). AFRIL is a small, locally run charity based in Lewisham. They work to relieve poverty and social isolation amongst refugees and asylum seekers, by







providing education, family support services, and access to emergency supplies.Each week they currently help an average of 120 people in our local community.

Many of the families that AFRIL helps are living on as little as £36.50 a week. The Helping Hands Foodbank aims to provide these families with much needed food. Families are assessed by AFRIL then referred to the foodbank where they can receive a weekly supply of fresh, dried and tinned foods, as well tea and toast when they pop in.

At Brindishe Green we have been talking to the children about the importance of sharing what we have, and helping those in our community who are less fortunate than ourselves. This week, some visitors from The Good Shepherd and St Peter's Church have visited to talk to the children about the Foodbank and how it helps refugee families.

This half term we will be collecting donations of **breakfast items - cereal, longlife milk and long life fruit juice**. Please donate what you can to this excellent cause! The collecting box is in the main foyer so please give generously. Thank you!
