Parents as partners

We recognise the importance parents and carers play in a child's learning. As a primary care provider you are your child's first educators and we greatly value any input, opinions and information you can share with us about your child's learning and progress.

We provide many opportunities for parents and carers to take an active part in their child's education. These include:

- Stay and play sessions where parents and carers are welcomed to join in with our sessions.
- Family expeditions where parents and carers are invited to come along and support us visiting local parks and spaces.
- Regular newsletters
- Home learning Its learning

Most importantly, your child's teachers are available to talk to you if you have issues or concerns or you can email them or ask them to call you.

## How to help your child to be ready for nursery

Encourage your child to be as independent as possible even if it takes far longer for them to get ready - putting on their own coat, pouring a drink of water, putting things away, going to the toilet and washing their hands.

Get them used to a routine of reasonably early to bed and up early enough for you and your child to have a stress free time to get ready for nursery AM session or to eat lunch and be ready for PM nursery.

Share stories, books and rhymes. Read to them every day.

Count everything and share things out.

Talk to them all the time. Name familiar things and discuss what they see around them and what things are for. Talk about what you see when you are out and about.

Always talk about nursery as a positive and fun experience.





All EYFS classes have a self-selection snack area where children can choose a fruit or vegetable snack and a drink of water or milk.

Fresh water is available at all times.

#### The early years curriculum

The children in the Nursery class follow the early years foundation stage curriculum.

# Planning In the Moment

Choose it, use it and put it away!

**PITM** involves allowing child initiated, real time, learning through play based on capturing the interest of the children.

Focus children being the basis of the planning

The staff through careful observation, capture and utilise the children's natural desire to learn, explore and question.

The classrooms offer high quality core provisions and an environment that enables the adults to seize the moments when a child shows a level of interest and curiosity that can be drawn out, enhanced and developed and these are 'teachable moments'. They happen throughout the day.

The children are encouraged to be independent learners and take ownership of their learning environments – inside and outside.
