

Plans for full reopening in September 2020

All children in Year 1 – 6 will return to Brindishe Green on **Monday 7th September**.



School attendance is **compulsory** and we would like all children back in school.



Each year group will form a 'bubble'. Most learning will happen within the classroom. During playtimes, lunchtimes and at the end of the day the children will be mixed as a year group bubble.



Children must sanitise or **wash their hands** every time they enter the school and during the day. School staff will reinforce how to keep hands clean.



The school will be **cleaned** more regularly, during the school day and at the end of each day.



Guidance says children **do not** need to wear a mask. However, there will be a Mask Station on premises for children to safely remove their mask before entering school **IF** they wear one on the journey.

We encourage parents and carers to wear a mask while on school premises, to reduce the risk of virus transmission among families.

Drop off at the start of the day



Please drop your child off at school at your **allocated time**.

It is important that you are on time!

You will not be able to come onto the school premises before your allocated time. If you need to wait outside the main gate, please remember to **socially distance from other families**. Please keep your child/children by your side.

All children must arrive through the **MAIN GATE on Beacon Road**. Year 1 and 2 will meet their teacher in the playground. Years 3 – 6 will walk round to their classroom on their own. Lots of staff will be around to support the children.

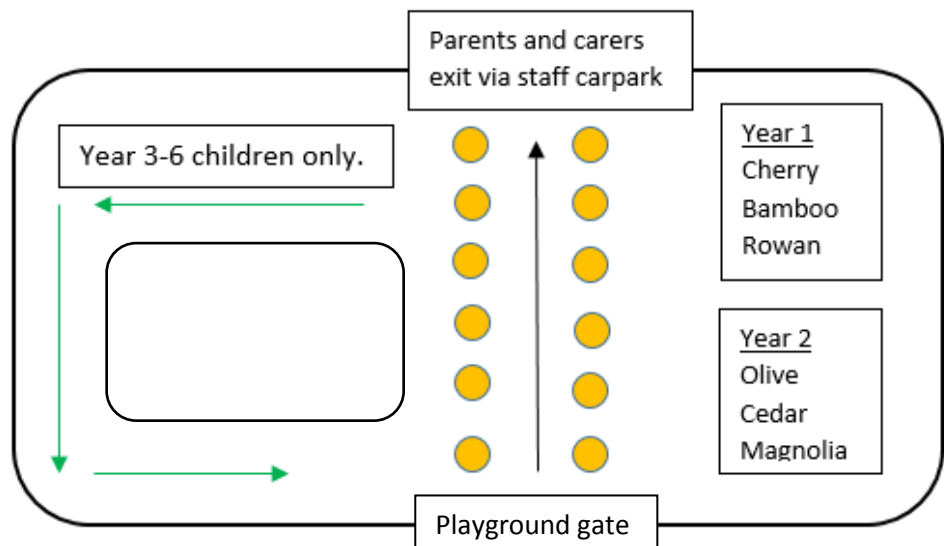


Parents and carers must say ‘See you soon!’ and wave goodbye in the playground and continue walking towards the staff carpark. Please do not cross over the orange cones. Parents and carers will leave the premises through the staff carpark.

Map of the playground



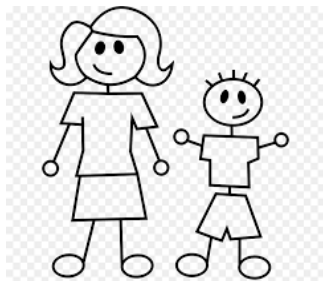
Pick up at the end of the day



Only arrive at your pick up time as we are trying to reduce the number of families in the playground. If you arrive early, please wait on Beacon Road and **do not block the gate**.



Family Surname Group	So, if your surname is....	End of the day pick up time
A – G	Adams	3.00pm – 3.10pm
H – P	Mohammed	3.10pm – 3.20pm
Q – Z	Williams	3.20pm – 3.30pm



If you are collecting children with different surnames, you should come to school at the later time.

If you have a child in Reception or Nursery you **must** collect them first (using the small gate on Beacon Road).

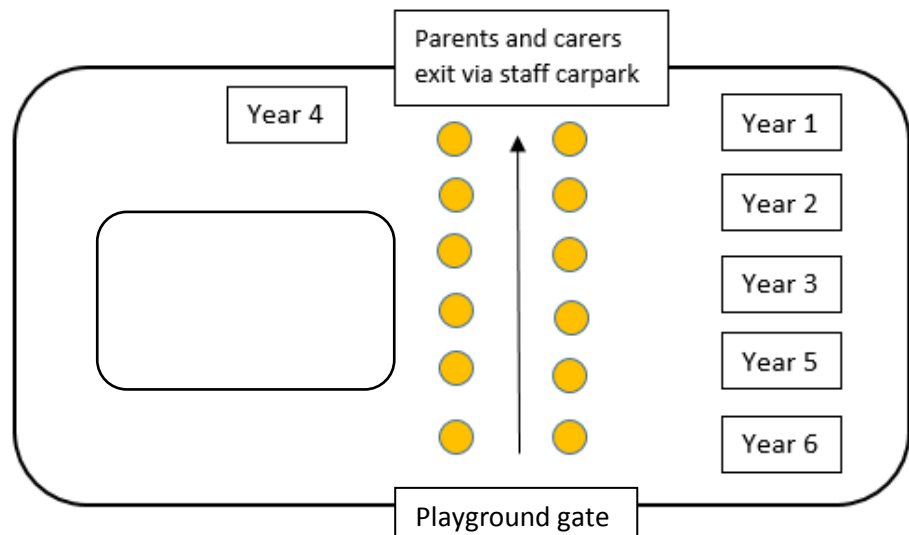


You must leave quickly **through the staff carpark** as soon as you have collected your child/children.

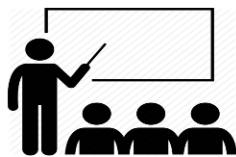


Please be prepared to **stop and wait** if asked by a member of staff to allow children to pass or maintain social distancing.

What does my child need to know before they start school?



Children will start in their new class, with their new teacher. **They should know their new class name and teacher before they come to school.**

Children will be given plenty of time to **share stories and talk through any worries.**



Children **must** bring a reusable, labelled **water bottle** and a small bag.

The classrooms will be set up so that the children are predominantly facing the front of the class.



There will be **staggered break and lunchtimes** where the children will be allowed to play outside in their zones.

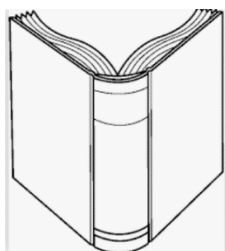
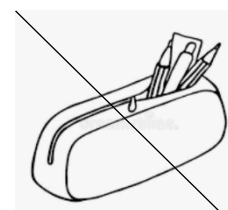
Children will have lunch with children in their Bubble.

Hot school dinners will be eaten in the hall. Children will sit in the hall for 30 minutes.

Packed lunches will be eaten in a classroom. Children will bring their rubbish home in their lunch box.



Each child will be given all the equipment they need. Children **must not** bring any equipment from home.



Reading books will be sent home.
Homework will be on Itslearning.

Children must **come to school in their outdoor PE kit** on their allocated PE day.
