Dear families, governors, neighbours and staff,

On Monday, Miss Matthews and Miss Campbell kick started the week with assemblies for the children in Years 2-6 on racism and how it is everyone's job to stop it. The children explored what race is, why people move/moved around the world, and why where you or your family came/comes from is important but shouldn't be important to others. We discussed what racism is, what it looks like, how it makes people feel and how we can all stop it. Today is 'Show Racism the Red Card Day,' and we are delighted with how many people in our school community took part by wearing red.

This week, all three Year 1 classes visited Mountsfield Park where they talked about the seasons and went on a senses walk in nature, exploring the different sights, smells and sounds around them. After tasting and evaluating a range of shop bought smoothies, Year 2 visited Lewisham Market to buy their own fruits so they could design and make their own healthy drinks. The children were delighted with the variety of fruit they were able to buy and staff were very grateful to the people working on the stalls for their kindness and generosity.

Year 6 have had a very busy week. On Thursday they took part in a fantastic carousel of activities which taught them about the history and importance of The Notting Hill Carnival. On Tuesday, they welcomed some very interesting visitors...a snake, rat, giant snail, scorpion...but do not worry, as they hadn't just made their way to the top floor uninvited. They were brought into school by the company Zoo Labs, and helped the children to learn about classification of animals.

We have our very own Roots of Empathy Instructor, Mr Chris, who has attended intensive training and will plan and facilitate every visit. In return you and your baby will benefit from the support and encouragement of our instructor, not to mention 30 children cheering them on. We also promise to make you very nice cups of tea!

Each visit can work around your schedule and will be about 30 minutes long.
