Dear Parents/Carers of Macaw class,
Welcome to the new school term! We hope you all had a great break and are re-energised for the summer term!

English: The children will compose formal letters before moving on to creating and describing a Tudor character and writing a balanced argument about the British Museum's collection of the ancient Benin bronzes.

Maths

In our new Maths groups, we will be focusing on ensuring the children are confident in all key objectives before moving up to year 6. This will include reading a range of graphs and understanding and manipulating shapes.

Science We will be learning about Forces and will also learn about the lifecycle of animals including humans. We will look at infancy and childhood, adolescence and puberty, reproduction, gestation and adulthood.

D.T. & Music

In music, we are combining disciplines in the Performing Arts, which we will perform to you on Thursday 21st May! In DT, we are making tote bags out of old T-shirts.

History/Geography

This term we will be studying the Tudors, Mountains and the Ancient Kingdom of Benin.

PSHME

The main theme of this half term is keeping safe within and outside of the home, focusing on road, rail and safety around electronics.

RE

Year 5 will be learning about Sikhism, with a focus on the Guru Gobind Singh and the Sikh community.

ICT

In Computing, we will learn about programming conditions and outcomes leading to children creating their own electronic questionnaires.

MFL

Our Spanish focus will see us learning the names of the planets and describing them, making use of our vocabulary for description - colour, size.

P.E.

Outdoor PE will be cricket - hopefully resulting in a fun year group tournament. Indoor PE will begin with athletics in preparation for Sports day.
