Keeping the Children Safe in the Sun

Thank you to all the parents who have sent their children to school this week prepared for the hot sunny weather. Last week we asked for all children to come to school with a sunhat, a bottle of water, suncream applied before coming to school and suitable clothing (toes, tummies and shoulders covered).

In addition to applying a high factor suncream to your child before they come to school, we would like to clarify that it is okay to send your child to school with suncream (no aerosol spray). This must have their name clearly written on it, or be placed in a small labelled sandwich bag, and the child must give it to their class teacher when they come into school.

Please note, that all children who bring in suncream, no matter how young they are, will need to apply the cream themselves, so please ensure they know how to do this. Staff are not allowed to apply cream.
