PPA time

All teachers are allocated a set amount of PPA (Planning, Preparation and Assessment) time based on the number of hours they work with children in school. From September our PPA team will include Ms Jonnette Bowen, the Senior Leadership Team and Higher Level Teaching Assistants who know our school and the children very well. We will try to keep to the same person each half term, whenever possible.

Changes to the Timings of the School Day from September 2023

As of September 2023, the government have increased their requirements on schools to have children in school to 32.5 hours per week. This means that we need to increase the amount of time that children at Brindishe Green need to be in school by **15 minutes each day**.
