Dear families, governors, neighbours and staff,

Despite the fact most of our children were only in school for three days, they have certainly been busy. Year 5 have been to Sutcliffe Park today to use their gymnastics equipment as part of their PE lessons. Year 3 children have been learning about the Sikh place of worship and the importance of treating everyone equally. Year 6 have been learning about Climate Change.

On Monday this week, our children in Years 5 and 6 took part in workshops run by the NSPCC. This follows on from assemblies that were led by the Senior Leadership Team a couple of weeks ago. They focused on helping the children to recognise the different types of abuse and how they can keep themselves safe.

Also on Monday, our children in Years 2-4 were taught how to keep themselves safe if someone they do now know, asks them to do something or go somewhere. They learnt that most people they do not know are safe and kind, however if someone asks them to go with them, they must never go.
