NOTIFICATION OF CLASS CLOSURES

On Friday 20th January, we wrote to you regarding the upcoming strikes that have been arranged by the National Education Union, in protest of teachers' pay and conditions, and school funding. The vast majority of the teachers at Brindishe Green are members of the NEU, and therefore, **the majority of classes will be closed** on **Wednesday 1st February**. Some teachers are part of other unions that, at this time, are not striking.

I am sure that you will understand that our dedicated and hardworking teachers have not taken this decision lightly. The NEU explain: "This is not about a pay rise but correcting historic real-terms pay cuts. Teachers have lost 23% in real-terms since 2010, and support staff 27% over the same period. The average 5% pay rise for teachers this year is some 7% behind inflation. In the midst of a cost of living crisis, that is an unsustainable situation."

Some classes will be OPEN on Wednesday 1st February and children may come into school:

ALL other classes will be closed.

All other classes will be closed. Children in these classes must not come to school

If any changes occur, we will inform parents/carers as soon as we are able to do so.

Further information regarding the next planned strike on 2nd March will be sent in due course.

Communication with Staff

As you know, good communication between home and school is very important. We value the strong relationships that we build and maintain with you, and we hope that you feel that the school are here to listen and work closely with you.

If you need to relay a message to the school which requires an immediate response, we recommend that you call or email the school office team, and they can decide if it is urgent and ensure that the right person receives the message. After a couple of days, if you feel your email has been missed, please forward it again.
