Notification of further NEU Teachers' Strike Dates

Since January, we have been in constant communication with you all regarding the strikes that were arranged by the National Education Union, in protest of teachers' pay and conditions, and school funding. The NEU (National Education Union) held a ballot on a recent Government pay offer that saw 98% of those teacher members who took part in England, reject the deal, as it was not fully funded. The NEU is now calling for negotiations with the government to begin again.

The further strike dates that have been announced are Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July

The vast majority of the teachers at Brindishe Schools are members of the NEU, and therefore, **the majority of classes will be closed.** Some teachers are part of other unions that, at this time, are not striking.

As always, each individual Brindishe School will be in contact with you nearer the time to let you know which classes will be closed and which will be open to children. It is expected that if your child's class is open on a planned strike day, that they are in school as usual to avoid an unauthorised absence.
