
What is happening next week?

On 11th, 12th and 13th October we will be collecting tinned tomatoes for AFRIL Helping Hands Foodbank. On Monday 9th, Reverend Juliet will come and speak to the older children in assembly on the importance of helping to look after others who are less fortunate.

The 'Helping Hands Foodbank' is a joint project between the Church of the Good Shepherd with St Peter (in Lee) and Action for Refugees in Lewisham (AFRIL). AFRIL is a small, locally-run charity based in Lewisham. They work to relieve poverty and social isolation amongst refugees and asylum seekers, by providing education, family support services, and access to emergency supplies. They are always very appreciative of the support and generosity of Brindishe Green families.



We are very grateful to everyone who is able to buy a book.






Reading and Learning Volunteers
