
Newsletter Friday 2nd February 2024



What has been happening this week?

This week our children in Years 3-6 learnt about **World Religion Day**, and the importance of learning from and respecting people of all faiths and none, in our community and across the world.

On Tuesday our **Nursery** children visited Manor House Gardens, on Friday **Puffin and Red Kite** went to St. Paul's/Tate Modern and **Year 3** took part in an exciting Egyptian Workshop.



On Tuesday, Ms Kugathasan, Mr Keith and our **Eco-Warriors** attended the **Big Schools' Climate Event** at The Horniman Museum. The children took part in a variety of workshops where they discovered many strategies they can use to protect the environment. Using the 710 Christmas cards you kindly brought in to school to be recycled, they got the chance to demonstrate their entrepreneurial skills in a pitch that resembled Dragon's Den. **We are thrilled to tell you they won £400 worth of funding**, which will go towards improving our Edible Playground. What is happening next week?

Next week is **Children's Mental Health Week** and children across the school will be learning how important it is to use their voice and to be heard. They will learn ways to look after their mental health and how to communicate if they are feeling sad, anxious or afraid.

Parent/Carer Governor Elections

If you haven't already, please do make sure you have your vote counted for the Brindishe Federation Parent/Carer Governor. On Wednesday this week, all families in our federation community were sent the 8 supporting statements from our nominees and your ballot papers. **The ballot boxes will close at 9am on Friday 9th February** and we will let you know the outcome of the elections on Monday 19th February. **It is vital that each parent/carer plays their part in this process and has their vote counted.**

New Signing - In System for Children

If your child arrives after 8.45 and the gate is closed, or is returning from an appointment, you will need to accompany your child to the main door.

You will then be asked to sign your child into school using the signing-in screen in the front foyer.

MMR Vaccinations

With Measles cases rising in London, Lewisham's Public Health team is monitoring the situation and working closely with healthcare partners to raise awareness and to ensure those who need the vaccination get it. The key message from council and healthcare partners is that **two doses of the MMR vaccine** provide the best protection against measles, mumps and rubella.

If a child has missed one or both doses, their parent or carer should contact their GP practice to book an appointment or visit the NHS website for more information.

BRECK FOUNDATION - Children's Workshops and Parents/Carer Talk

The Breck foundation is a charity organisation that was founded in 2014 in response to the tragic loss of Breck Bednar, a 14-year-old boy who was groomed and murdered by someone he met online. Their work aims to prevent this from ever happening again. They reach thousands of children and young people in schools and other community settings every year with Breck's story. Their talks and educational materials fill a gap in the current UK curriculum that otherwise leaves children vulnerable to online grooming and exploitation. On **8th February**, the foundation will deliver a powerful and compelling **online safety presentation** using Breck's story to educate everyone on the dangers that children and young people face online for all children in **Years 3-6**.

In addition, there will be a **parent workshop via Zoom on 7th February at 6pm**. We hope to see many parents as possible since our children's safety is extremely important to us all.
