# Free school meals for children in Reception to Year 6 for 2023/2024 – Mayors Universal Free School Meals Expansion.

As you are aware, from September all pupils will be able to receive a school meal at no cost to their parent/carer. This is known as The Mayors Universal Free School Expansion and is a government initiative.

As this is very new, we have allocated a 3-week trial period for all children in Key Stage 2 who may wish to transfer from packed lunch to school meals. During the first 3 weeks of term, your child/children can try the school meals (free of charge) provided by Radish and teachers will take a daily 'lunch register' during this time. At the end of the 3 weeks, we ask that parents/carers and children make a definite decision as to whether they would like to continue with school meals free of charge or return to a packed lunch option. If your child wishes to remain packed lunch from September, then please continue to send them in with a named, healthy packed lunch box.

The Autumn Term School Meals menses can be found on our school website. From September, we will also be offering Upper Key Stage 2 (Years 5 & 6) the option of a baguette with a choice of fillings.
