Head Lice

Several cases of head lice have been reported in school recently. We encourage you to check your child's hair regularly and treat immediately if you find any eggs or lice. Please note this is a very common condition in children. We encourage all children with long hair to come to school with their hair tied back.

Head lice can be treated using conditioner, tea tree oil or shop bought products with a fine-tooth comb. You will need to treat the whole family and wash towels and bedding. Please keep checking your child's hair over a period of time to prevent any further cases.
