# What has been happening this week?

What a busy week! Cassowary class started their swimming lessons at Lewisham Glass Mill Leisure Centre, we collected tins for the AFRIL foodbank, we ran our first Scholastic Book Fair of the year and the BFG had their first cake sale. #### Open Classrooms - Years 1, 3 and 5

On **Thursday from 3.20-3.45**, we will welcome parents/carers of children in Years 1, 3 and 5 to come and look at their books in our first **Open Classrooms.** The class teacher will take you to the room from the playground at the end of the school day. This is an **informal opportunity** for your child to show you what they have been learning and to show you around their classroom. If you have two children in these year groups there will be plenty of time to visit one room and then pop along to the other. **Formal Teacher/Parent meetings will take place in Autumn 2.** 

Year 2, 4 and 6 will have their Open Classroom after half term.

#### **ME Books**

Look out for your children's new ME Book activities which came home with the children today. There is a focus on World Food Day and Black History Month. There are also some additional fun family tasks that can be completed over half term. Books should be returned to school before Thursday 2nd November.

#### **Black History Month**

This week, children across the school have been learning about inspirational Black Women such as Coco Gauff, Simone Biles, and different Motown singers.

Children have also learnt about Black women in the historical period they are learning about, such as Year 4 who learnt about the Ivory Bangle Lady who was alive in Roman Britain.
