School Street - Beacon Road

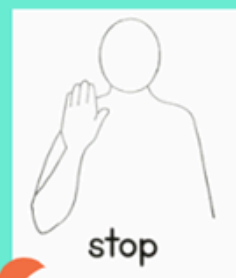
