Time - tap one finger on your wrist twice as if tapping your watch.

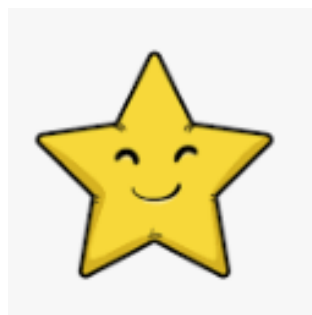
