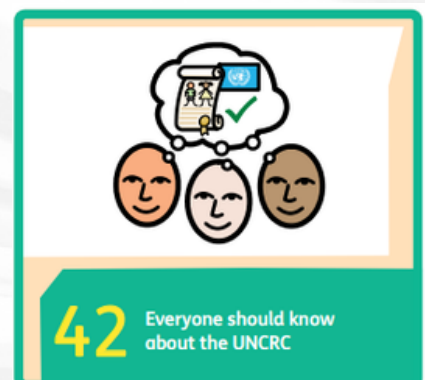
Updating Details
