Sponsored Event - Raising money for the victims of the earthquake in Turkey and Syria

A couple of weeks ago we wrote to you to let you know that as a school community we hoped to raise money for the victims of the earthquake in Syria and Turkey. We have decided to do a whole school sponsored event over the Easter holiday - something we hope all of our children will be able to take part in. The money raised from this will be put together with the money collected in the buckets outside school.

In assembly on Monday we shared with the children the challenges they could do, and how to complete their sponsorship form. We explained that they could do a couple of the challenges, most of them, or even all of them. The children should have already brought home a copy of the sponsorship form, and one is also attached to your Newsfeed on Weduc.

Sponsorship money and forms should be returned to school on **Wednesday 19th April.** The children are excited to see which class raises the most money.

Drop Off and Collection

As a school with 647 children, it is understandably busy at drop off and collection times, and whilst we appreciate that many parents/carers are keen to drop off and collect children quickly, we have seen an increase in adult frustration and conflict this term.

Prior to Covid 19, Brindishe Green has always operated a system where all children from Years 1-6 enter and leave the main gate at the start and end of the day. During the Covid pandemic, to increase social distancing, the car park exit was used to create a one-way system. This was always only going to be a temporary solution and robust risk assessments, staffing and time were put into place to allow this to happen. This is not a system we will return to.

We are in the process of finding ways to manage the stream of traffic, particularly at the end of the day, possibly with 'Way in' or 'Way out' markings or metal railings. In the meantime, we ask that all parents/carers/visitors please show mutual respect and patience towards each other and staff.

Changes to Sportacus Clubs – FSM places

From after Easter, only two Free School Meal eligible places (parent/carer pays 50% of the total cost) will be offered per club per term (lunch and after school). These places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Please note if a FSM eligible child would like to attend more than one club, and receives one of the 50% charge places, then parents/carers will be required to pay 100% for the second club.
