SNACKS



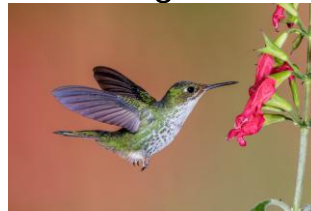

Information meeting for parents & carers



We will be holding an information meeting for parents on **Thursday 17th October**. to talk about ways of supporting your child at home with their communication, physical, and personal & social skills.

This term we will be focusing on settling in and getting to know the children's interests and needs. We will use our observations of the children to plan activities that the children will enjoy, encourage skill development, encourage exploration and investigation, and widen the children's experiences.

- We will be sharing some of our favourite stories each day including Owl babies, Brown bear, brown bear, 123 Do the dinosaur, We're going on a bear hunt, Whatever Next and Dear Zoo.
- We will be learning about what we do in the nursery and how we keep safe.
- We will be playing games and learning how to use the climbing equipment outside.
- We will be enjoying spending time in our role play house inside and our vet surgery outside.
- We will be learning about different materials – water, sand, flour and playdough.
- We will be learning and singing songs and rhymes about getting to know each other, colours, animals...
- We will be making pictures and models using different materials and techniques.
