This term we will be following the children's interests and providing activities linked to favourite nursery rhymes.

We will use our observations of the children to plan activities that the children will enjoy, encourage skill development, exploration and investigation, and widen the children's experiences.

- We will be sharing some of our favourite stories and nursery rhymes. This will support our learning in Phase 1 phonics. Stories will include The Very Busy Spider, Day Monkey, Night Monkey, The bus is for us, It's an emergency, The tiger who came to tea and We are all welcome here.
- We will be learning about Winter celebrations – Diwali and Christmas
- We will be learning about what we can do in the nursery and how we keep safe.
- We will be learning how to play alongside and with other children.
- We will be playing games and learning how to use the resources and climbing equipment outside.
- We will be learning about different materials – water, sand, flour and playdough.
- We will be learning about being creative – making pictures and models using different materials and techniques.
