- We will be learning about the Lunar New Year.
- We will be learning about what we can do in the nursery and how we keep safe.
- We will be learning how to play alongside and with other children.
- We will be playing games and learning how to use the resources and climbing equipment outside.
- We will be learning about different materials – water, sand, flour and playdough.
- We will be learning in daily whole class sessions. Some of these sessions will follow our phase 1 phonics plan.
