This week at Brindishe Green

Well done to our year 6 children for completing a very difficult few days of mock SATs during the last week of term. There has been a real buzz of energy and commitment upstairs and you should all be very proud of your dedication and achievements. You will also now be in a very strong position for the real SATs on May 14th and I know your teachers are very pleased with your efforts and hard work.

Huge congratulations to the many, many children who took part in our annual Musician's Concert on Monday evening. This was undoubtedly the best concert of this kind ever at Brindishe Green! Children played and sang with great confidence, they were well rehearsed and the standard of musicianship was amazing! Many thanks to the adults who supported on the evening and to Nate Horgan and Daisy Johnson for organizing the concert for us.

Good attendance

At Brindishe Green good attendance is 96% or above.

Good attendance means that children can keep up with their learning and therefore have every chance of making good progress across the year. There is a direct link between low attendance and low attainment.

We expect every child to be in school during term time. Term time accounts for just 190 days each year, with the remaining 175 days given over to school holiday. There are in fact 13 weeks of school holiday during the year and we expect family holidays to be taken during school holiday dates.

Given the amount of holiday time children have, it is disappointing still to receive absence requests for family holidays during term time. As Headteacher I am unable to authorise such

absence requests unless there are exceptional circumstances which must be fully documented in writing.

Exceptional circumstances do not include, for example, cheaper travel, relatives' birthdays or other celebrations, or visiting family abroad.

Families should be aware that they may be subject to a fine of £120 per parent, (per child) if their child is absent during term time without permission. Penalty notices are issued by the local authority.

Thank you to the very many families who make sure their child is in school, on time, every day during term time and who therefore ensure their child has the best possible chances of achieving well and making good progress.
