


Brindishe Green Covid Bulletin

London - Tier 2 Restrictions

From Saturday 17th October, London has been placed under Tier 2 restrictions (High). This now means:

		
<p>You must not socialise with people you do not live with in private homes.</p>	<p>You must not socialise in a group of more than 6 people outside. This includes in a park, at the beach or in a garden. This includes children.</p>	<p>Wherever possible, stay 2 metres apart from people you do not live with, unless they are in your support or childcare bubble.</p>
		
<p>Work from home where possible.</p>	<p>You must not socialise with people you do not live with inside public places such as restaurants, pubs and cafes.</p>	<p>Try not to share a car with people you do not live with. Reduce the number of journeys you take where possible.</p>

Covid Symptoms – If you, your child or a member of your house hold develops Covid symptoms (a high temperature, a persistent cough or the loss of smell or taste), you should contact 119 and get a Covid test. Your whole household must self-isolate for 14 days or until the result comes back negative. **Please let the school know straight away of your child’s test results.**

Help to Keep Brindishe Green Safe and Our Children at School

We ask that all families support us in keeping children, staff and community safe:

- Socially distance outside school when you are waiting to collect your child. Please keep clear of the yellow box by the gate.
- Please wear a face covering/mask when on school premises, if possible.
- Follow the one-way system during drop off and collection.
- Children should only bring in a reusable water bottle and a book bag. Home learning, or learning that is completed when self-isolating or during a lockdown, is to be posted on Itslearning.
- Remind your child of the importance of washing their hands.
- Please read our texts, emails and letters to keep up to date with new information.

Half Term - Currently there is a lot of speculation in the press that half term will be extended to 2 weeks. However, at present this is not the case. **Half term is during the week Monday 26th – Friday 30th October.** If anything changes, we will let you know as soon as possible via text and email.

Contact Details – If we are told that a child or member of staff has had a positive Covid test, we will immediately contact Lewisham Public Health who will tell us if we have to close a bubble. We will then communicate this information with you via text or email. **Please check with the office that we have your correct phone number and email address.**
