


Online Safety Bulletin - Setting Filters on YouTube

YouTube's safety mode allows parents to restrict the content their children see. When you opt into **YouTube Restricted Mode**, mature content and age-restricted videos won't show up in a search, related videos, playlists, shows and movies.

Here's how to do it:

1. Open YouTube
2. Click on the avatar or three dots on the top right corner.
3. At the very bottom it says restricted mode.
4. Click to turn it on!



Gold Rights Respecting –

This week's article for you to talk about with your family is...

Article 14: Every child has the right to think and believe what they want and to practise their religion, as long as they are not stopping other people from enjoying their rights. Governments must respect the rights of parents to give their children information about this right.

At Brindishe Schools we teach our children that everyone has the right to their own religion, faith or belief and we respect this.

Cards for children and tokens of appreciation for staff
